- Bridgewhiz and the Whizkids club continues to provide opportunities for kids to learn and play bridge online. These programs also evolved to support other activities for youth bridge.


Teachers and partner organizations played a key role in helping us accomplish our goals. Much of our focus continues to be on youth and young adult bridge.

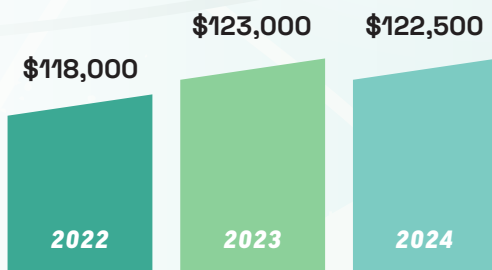

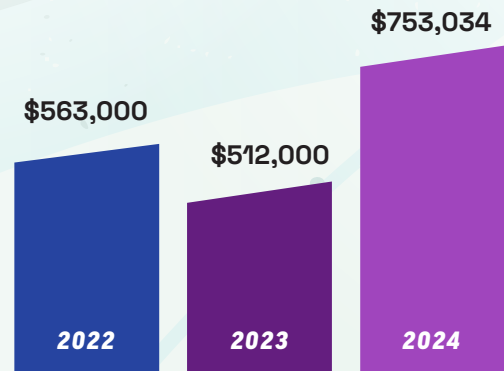

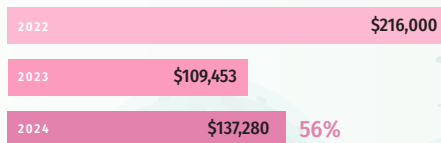
## TOTAL OPERATING REVENUE



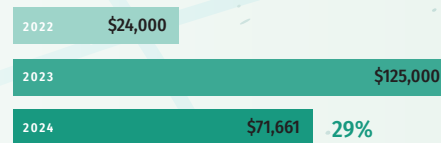

## MEET ALEX: YOUNG BRIDGEWHIZ AND RISING STAR

ACBL EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION

Alex is a young BridgeWhiz student achieving great strides in the bridge world. He is exactly the optimism the world needs, and is playing his way up to upcoming U16 tournaments later in 2025. We caught up with Alex and his mother, Anna, for this interview about bridge and the game's future.

### FIRST, TELL US ABOUT YOUR USUAL INTERESTS OUTSIDE OF PLAYING BRIDGE.

**Alex:** Besides bridge, I am passionate about piano, math, reading, and playing chess (but bridge is superseding chess).

### IS THERE ANY BRIDGE HISTORY IN THE FAMILY?

**Alex:** There is no bridge history in the family (sadly). I tried getting my parents to play it, but they prefer to do other things!

### WHERE DID YOU FIRST DEVELOP YOUR INTEREST IN BRIDGE?

**Alex:** I developed my interest in bridge about two years ago, in June 2023, when my mom's friend (Uncle Tony) introduced it to me. My mom was curious why Uncle Tony had suggested bridge to me and we later found out that he thought I might like bridge because I like numbers, detailed rules, logical thinking, and I have a pretty good memory.

He also knew that my parents have been wanting me to learn more social skills and he thought that bridge might help me in that area because "playing bridge requires some verbal interaction/discussion with opponents, usually in a very controlled and civilized manner."

Uncle Tony was very nice to give me a few bridge lessons over Zoom and I got hooked. During my free time I read books that Uncle Tony recommended, such as Audrey Grant books.

**LEARNING TO PLAY BRIDGE WILL NURTURE A CHILD'S TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL COMPETITIVE SPIRIT, BUILD SOCIAL SKILLS, AND ENHANCE DEDUCTIVE REASONING AND MATH ABILITIES.**

- BridgeWhiz is designed for beginner bridge players, with opportunities for graduates to continue lessons at all skill levels through grade 12.
- Weekly classes are offered at different times in multiple time zones to accommodate busy schedules.
- Our partners include the American Contract Bridge League (ACBL), American Bridge Teachers Association (ABTA), and SharkBridge.
- All teachers are fully vetted, certified bridge teachers with expertise in the SharkBridge teacher console.
- An assistant teacher is assigned to every teacher to assist in digitally monitoring each child's screen to ensure no student falls behind.
- Opportunities to play in youth tournaments locally, nationally, and internationally.

## TELL READERS MORE ABOUT YOUR CONNECTION WITH BRIDGEWHIZ.

**Alex:** Because Tony and his family live in CA, it was hard to meet online. My mom learned about the ACBL from attending a seminar on gifted education when a presenter mentioned bridge as an example of a great activity for gifted kids.

After emailing the ACBL, my mom found out about BridgeWhiz from Ms. Barbara Clark. I quickly joined BridgeWhiz and took classes there for about a year and loved it. I learned a lot from the classes and it is also nice to play bridge with other kids.

## HOW DID YOU FURTHER DEVELOP YOUR INTEREST IN BRIDGE?

**Alex:** I tried reading as many bridge books as I can find in my local library (there needs to be more!). For Christmas, I asked for bridge books like books by Hugh Kelsey and Eric Rodwell.

Also, after taking BridgeWhiz classes, I got more and more passionate about the game. I want to thank BridgeWhiz for their wonderful teachers! Coach Jane, Coach Dawn, Coach Keith and Coach Al are AMAZING! Special shoutout to Coach Keith for being extra generous with his time and agreeing to partner up with me in my very first (online) tournament (in Fall 2024).

I wanted to play more tournaments so I asked my mom to look for partners. She emailed Ms. Barbara Clark who emailed more than a dozen people and Ms. Amber Lin wrote back and told us about USBF! I joined one of their meetings and Mr. Cornelius Duffie thought I was good enough to compete and I also got to meet Mr. Adam Kaplan online. (And I just watched Double Dummy with my family just a few weeks before joining USBF.)

I wish there were more in-person clubs in New Jersey, especially for young players: the nearest club only meets during school hours!

## HOW DO YOU BALANCE BRIDGE, SCHOOL, AND LIFE?

**Alex:** It can be hard to balance bridge, school, and life, but my parents and I try to make sure I get all the things I need to get done before I log on. I usually do my homework right after I get home. When possible, I practice piano before my bridge games.

## WHAT ARE SOME OF YOUR FAVORITE ACCOMPLISHMENTS?

**Alex:** In December I had an amazing opportunity (thanks to Ms. Amber Lin and all the USBF mentors) to go to Atlanta to see if I can qualify for one of the USA teams. My family and I can't believe I made it to the USA1 team. I am so happy to be training with very experienced coaches and having the opportunity to play with super bright, passionate, and accomplished bridge peers.

## WHERE DO YOU SEE YOUR BRIDGE FUTURE HEADING TO?

**Alex:** I am hoping that my team and I can win the U16 World Champion this summer!

## HOW HAS BRIDGEWHIZ IMPACTED YOU AND OTHERS?

**Alex:** BridgeWhiz helped me pursue something that I really enjoy, and I think it could do the same for many others. Everyone should play bridge! And I tell my parents that it will improve their memory and maybe even help prevent Alzheimer's. Thank you so much for the support that BridgeWhiz gave me on my bridge journey!

## IN 2024, CONTRIBUTIONS TO SPARK! LED TO MANY SUCCESES, INCLUDING:

- In person and hybrid youth summer camps targeted toward bridge education and play.
- New opportunities to connect youth players - from partnerships with bridge clubs and Boys & Girls Clubs to juniors partnering and playing with seniors in living facilities.
- Opportunities for juniors to serve as peer mentors in bridge learning and play.
- Travel support for players attending the USA Bridge Camp + Championships in Las Vegas in December.
- Travel support for college students attending the annual North American Collegiate Bridge Bowl in Toronto, along with scholarships.
- “Junior Nights” at North American Bridge Championships for junior players from all over the world who attend the tournament.
- Travel support for the USA student team to compete in the FISU University Championships.
- Travel support for the North American juniors to compete in the World Youth Transnationals in Poland.
- Supporting programming that engages teachers in incorporating bridge education in school curriculum.



By supporting the ACBL Education Foundation and the Spark! fund, our donors have made it possible for young players to focus on playing and growing their skills in bridge.

Like competing in sports or learning an instrument, playing in bridge tournaments provides opportunities for young players to hone their skills and travel stipends create a world of opportunity for these youth players to compete beyond their local level.

All travel stipends, which cover a portion of their expenses, have a bridge community service requirement of 10-15 hours per stipend. All the juniors who receive funding are asked to give back to the community and to continue to promote bridge in their lives. Most help by running their school bridge clubs and teaching bridge to many new players.

## **JUMP START BRIDGE IS PROMOTING THE GAME WHERE NO TEACHERS HAVE GONE BEFORE,**

**OFFERING BRIDGE TEACHING IN SCHOOLS  
BY NON-BRIDGE PLAYING TEACHERS.**



Between November 2023 and February 2025, statistics show success. About 343 teachers in 33 states (and 2 provinces) have registered 15,077 bridge students so far. In 2024, the ACBL Educational Foundation provided over \$75,000 to promote bridge—and the pledge for this year has grown to \$250,000.

We caught up with celebrity bridge teacher Patty Tucker and her team of stunning teachers for the details. Here's more about the powerful collaboration between Jump Start Bridge and the ACBL Educational Foundation.

### **TELL ME MORE ABOUT JUMP START BRIDGE AND WHAT IT'S ALL ABOUT.**

**Patty:** Post-pandemic it had become difficult (if not impossible) to obtain approval for bridge as a school option. Our 2021 Lebanon, Kentucky initiative reinforced the need to have school teachers personally involved... The only thing lacking was how to reach the teachers.

We discovered there were state conferences. From there we determined that we needed booth and marketing materials, and people willing to exhibit.

The last 3 1/2 years have been used to build a volunteer force of bridge players, refine our marketing, and experiment with the best practices to get non-bridge playing teachers involved.

### **WHERE DID THE COLLABORATION BETWEEN JUMP START BRIDGE AND THE ACBLEF BEGIN?**

**Patty:** A small private school in Lebanon, Kentucky reached out to us asking if we could train their teachers and help them build a bridge club. We suggested that we contact the ACBL Educational Foundation and see if they could help.

The initiative was very successful and since that summer the school has had more than 40 students actively involved in the after-school bridge club.

### **HOW HAS JUMP START BRIDGE AND ACBLEF CHANGED THE LANDSCAPE?**

**Patty:** Based on our success in Kentucky, Jump Start Bridge wanted to expand its efforts and reach out directly to school teachers. The vehicle to do that is at teacher conferences when teachers are actively looking for new ideas.

### **TELL ME MORE ABOUT THE ASSISTANCE YOU'VE RECEIVED FROM THE EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION.**

**Patty:** The ACBL Educational Foundation was instrumental in 2024 in our ability to build the infrastructure to launch. Without their help and support, it would not have been possible to expand our efforts quickly into training bridge players to support our appearance at gifted conferences and attend these conferences.







## WHAT'S ON THE CARDS FOR YOU AND YOUR TEACHERS NEXT?

**Patty:** Building support for existing classes, and branching out to attend math conferences. We must be confident the teachers have the materials and support they need, and the tools to continue in future years.

At the same time, we still need to build. We are at the tipping point of becoming the 'new thing' in education circles and cannot afford to lose our momentum!



## TEACHER TALK: JACQUELINE WORTENDYKE, CHALLENGER ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Jacqueline Wortendyke is another teacher embracing bridge for their students from Challenger Elementary School in Huntsville, Alabama.

"I've had students who have never been interested in math or numbers that can't wait to show up for bridge. They are eagerly using their math to determine their points at the start, for bidding, and to score each trick and game."

The ACBL Educational Foundation has played a huge role in its success, says Jacqueline. "The resources are amazing, and without the resources from the ACBL Educational Foundation we would not have had the courage to teach bridge."

Students can refer to books, booklets, and videos—and they're just as helpful for teachers who have never played bridge before.

"Without this program, we have many students who would never have been exposed to bridge. Everyone who has done it has loved

it. It's tremendously helped their math confidence, and it's helped them to be motivated to complete classwork so that they may come and play bridge."



## TEACHER TALK: KATRINA DAVIS, MORRIS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

Katrina Davis from Morris Elementary School in Huntsville, Alabama is one of the dedicated, star teachers promoting the game. "Jump Start Bridge has left a lasting impression on all my gifted students as it has exposed them to a way to collaborate, and use their mathematical skills in real-life competition."

Students are excited every time they have the chance to play, says Katrina.

"Each lesson is broken down, vocabulary is available, and the student workbooks are a familiar thing for the students." Students can return to past lessons if they get stuck, and volunteers make up for where instructional videos may not explain everything the first time.

Students are excited to have their first district tournament with other schools in May 2025. "A few schools in Huntsville City are making headway in the bridge program! Teachers and students are elated to come together to compete and showcase their knowledge and ability to play the game of bridge."

Katrina has seen the shyest students emerge from their shell, the most energetic students calm down long enough to watch the board, and struggling math students find their confidence. "Card games are a long-lost way to bring people together in a fun, competitive way."

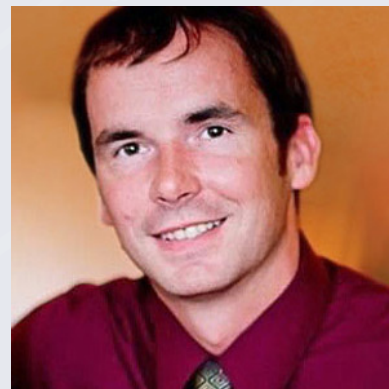

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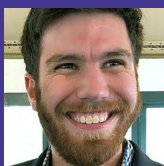
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
